SPECIFIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PIPEWORK MAINS

- (1) A pipework main includes the installation, maintenance and removal of the supply pipe (and drain for water and waste), which terminates in a stopcock and one connection to the equipment requiring the service at a position on the stand as indicated on the customer's dimensional drawing.
- (2) The main is not metered and the price includes the cost of water, air or gas used.
- (3) Additional connections off standard mains are only applicable at quoted price where due consideration has been given to:
 - a) Length of pipework runs (Normally 3m max).
 - b) Safety of pipework routing
 - c) Total capacity rating of standard main
 - d) Pressure drop limitation
 - e) Waste systems generally limited to use on double units only.

STANDARD CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- (1) In this document NEC means The National Exhibition Centre Limited.
- (2) If by reason of force majeure, labour difficulties or shortages of materials or any other cause outside the control of NEC, NEC is unable to provide all or any of the Services ordered by the Customer during the whole or any part of the duration of the exhibition, the Customer's rights shall be limited to the return of a corresponding proportion of the charges paid by him for such Services.
- (3) NEC, its employees or sub-Contractors or their employees will not be liable for damage to property or death or injury caused to persons by or in any way connected with the Services agreed to be provided or in any other way whatsoever, except only to the extent that NEC carries public liability insurance as specified in the licence agreement with the exhibition organiser PROVIDED that this exclusion of liability will not apply to claims for death or injury which is occasioned by the negligence of NEC, its employees, sub-Contractors or their employees.
- (4) On no account will NEC be liable for consequential or other direct or indirect loss suffered by the Customer howsoever caused.
- (5) NEC gives no warranty or guarantee to the Customer as to the quality of the Service, Equipment or in relation to the installation of any Service or Equipment.
- (6) NEC is not liable in any way for any damage, loss (whether direct or indirect) or cost of any kind suffered or borne by the Customer, caused or arising out of delay or failure to deliver the Service or Equipment to the Customer.
- (7) Orders for Services received or amended after the date specified on the front of this form will not be provided until after completion of orders received prior to this date. . Orders taken whilst the Customer is on site during build-up will be subject to a 20% surcharge and the NEC gives no guarantee as to the Services being implemented.
- (8) NEC reserves the right to refuse to process orders until full payment for the requested services has been received. This condition will be enforced for all orders placed during the build-up of an exhibition.
- (9) NEC has the exclusive right to install the equipment, and reserves the right to appoint a Contractor of its choice as Sub-Contractors for the installation of the Equipment and the provision of the Services
- (10) NEC reserves the right, where payment has not been made by the Customer, to suspend or disconnect the Services and recover its Equipment so far provided, until payment is made in full by the Customer to the NEC. This clause does not affect the right of NEC to make a charge for the Services and Equipment provided to the Customer up to the aforementioned suspension disconnection/repossession, which shall include the right of NEC to claim any loss it has sustained.
- (11) All products, goods, materials, plant and other such items ("Equipment") supplied by NEC to the Customer in connection with this Contract and the Service shall remain the property of NEC and no title shall pass to the Customer. Notwithstanding the above, once installation of the Equipment has taken place, the Equipment shall be deemed to be within the Customer's control and responsibility, and shall be at the Customer's sole risk until collected and control re-taken by the NEC. The Customer shall indemnify NEC for any loss or damage to the Equipment during the period of Customer control and responsibility and shall insure the Equipment up to its full replacement value.
- (12) The Customer shall at all times indemnify NEC against all actions, claims, demands, damages, expenses, compensation, costs, charges, liability and proceedings suffered or borne by the NEC arising from the Customer's negligence, the Customer's failure to comply with the conditions of this Contract, or any other conduct of the Customer connected with this Contract.
- (13) The Customer shall comply with all conditions imposed by NEC in relation to the Equipment and Services provided.
- (14) The Customer shall not remove the Equipment from the premises without the NEC prior written approval.
- (15) The Customer shall not tamper with the Equipment or attempt to repair it or mistreat it, and shall return the Equipment to the NEC in the same conditions as it was in before installation (fair wear and tear accepted).
- (16) The quoted prices for Services and Equipment are based on the current cost of materials, labour and other charges made to the NEC, and NEC reserves the right to adjust the subsequent price where necessary to reflect any changes to these costs/charge, and any alteration to the rates of value added tax or to statutory regulations.
- (17) Cancellation of orders will only be accepted when made in writing. Where written cancellation is received by NEC:
 - a) 5 working days or less prior to the start of build-up for the exhibition, the Customer shall be liable to pay to NEC the full rate for the Services ordered;
 - b) 6 or more working days prior to the start of building up for the exhibition the Customer shall be liable to pay to NEC 50% of the full rate for the Services ordered

The NEC reserves the right to apply a minimum charge of £50.00 for any cancellation.
- (18) Without prejudice to these Standard conditions of Contract, complaints with regard to supplies will not be accepted unless notification of such complaints is received in writing to the Technical Services Manager during the open period of the exhibition.
- (19) The proper law applicable to the Contract is English Law and the parties agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
- (20) A decision by the United Kingdom to join or not to join the Economic and Monetary Union will not itself cause this Contract to be terminated or entitle one party unilaterally to vary or terminate it.
- (21) No provision of this Contract is intended to or does confer upon any third party any benefit or right enforceable by that third party.
- (22) It is hereby agreed and declared that NEC is Contracting as managing agent of Birmingham City Council and that all rights and obligations of NEC hereunder shall be enforceable by and against the said Council accordingly. NEC represents and warrants that it has full power and authority to enter into this Contract on behalf of the said Council and is authorised to accept Service of all notices and proceedings arising hereunder.
- (23) The Customer shall not assign its rights or obligations under this Contract.
- (24) Any variation to this Contract must be evidenced in writing.
- (25) If any provision of this Contract is or shall become void in whole or part, the other provisions of these conditions shall remain fully valid and enforceable and the void provisions shall, where appropriate, be replaced in accordance with the meaning and purpose of these conditions.
- (26) These Standard Conditions of Contract apply in this Contract to the exclusion of any terms and conditions contained in the Customer's order which conflict or purport to modify them and to the exclusion of any conditions or warranties implied by common law or statute, as far as allowed.
- (27) NEC has the right to charge interest on any sums due to it from the Customer under this Contract at a rate of 4% per annum above the base rate of the Nat West Bank (as may vary from time to time) such interest to be calculated and accrue daily.
- (28) All prices exclude VAT @ 17.5%
